RESULTS: Human blood and semen were identified on the vaginal swabs, slides, one (1) bedspread, two (2) robes and slip. Human blood was identified on the green bedspread and pink gown.

No blood or semen was identified on the remaining items.

Genetic markers identified from the blood stains and the known blood of Julia Esparza were the same.

Genetic markers identified from the semen were the same as the known blood specimen of Gilbert Alejandro.

RESULTS (cont.):

Microscopic characteristics of hair from the quilt
bedspread were similar to the known hair of [REDACTED].

A DNA profile was obtained from the semen samples and
compared to the DNA profile of Gilbert Alejandro.

CONCLUSION: Genetic markers and DNA profiling of the semen
stains contained identical banding patterns as
Gilbert Alejandro and could only have originated
from him.

Genetic markers and DNA profiling of the blood
stains contained identical banding patterns as
Julia Esparza and could only have originated from
her.
